Traist cousing efter meist hertlye commendatiounes. I haif resawit zour wryting  
desyring me to lat zowe knew be wryt gif ze sall tak ye bur-  
ding wpone zowe to assuir ye Clangregor in my name  
and for my freindis serwandis and dependeris to ye aucht daye off  
December nixt yai gifand ye lyk. As to yat I haif wryttin  
instantlye for ye Lairdis of Weyme Glenlyownd and Lawers  
quha war confideratis in yat caus to cum heir and speik  
with me yat I may haif yair adwyss heirinto lyk as I haif  
zouris all redye be yis wryt. And efter as I haif  
spokin yame sall adverteiss zowe agane quhilk salbe within  
thre or four daies at ye farrest to ye quhilk I refar all  
vyer. And sa committis zowe to ye protectioun of ye Eternal  
God. Frome Dunkeld ye xxvij of October 1570.
